Rok:Bgr opens in Fort Lauderdale

Rok Bgr. Fort Lauderdale's first gastropub specializing in burgers, has opened at 208 SW 2nd St.

Their hand formed burgers are made with Angus beef aged a minimum of 21 days. Snacks and bar bites include tempura battered zucchini (\$6) with garlic aioli, fried pickles (\$5) and mini Kobe hot dogs (\$9).

Fries (\$4) are hand cut and all sauces are made in-house. I'm glad to see poutine (\$5) on the menu. This Canadian sometimes gets a craving for fries smothered with cheese curds and gravy.



The 10-ounce Rok Bgr is 10 bucks. There are an assortment of other burgers including turkey and tuna.

Off the burger menu, there are salads, meatloaf (\$14) and a classic BLT (\$7). More than 50 craft beers and a full menu of martinis complete the menu.

Rok:Bgr is open daily for lunch and dinner, until 2 a.m. weekdays and 4 a.m. Friday and Saturday nights. Call 954-525-7656.
